## The Musical Learning Journey:

- In KS<sub>3</sub>, students will have the opportunity to develop their musical skills through performance, composition and listening. We strongly believe that every child should have the opportunity to play a musical instrument. Students will learn how to play a range of musical instruments and how to perform them in a solo and ensemble context. They will also have the opportunity to develop their music technology skills through our ICT suite. This includes coding music and composing music for film.
- In KS<sub>4</sub>, students will be continuing to develop their performance and composition skills through the 'BTEC Tech' qualification. These are qualifications that are vocational and designed to be taught alongside traditional GCSEs. Because of the vocational nature of the course, the students will have the chance to organise events and learn the skills required to succeed in the music industry.



## Why study music at Key Stage Music 4?

- You will be gaining skills that you will require to succeed in the music industry such as event organisation and intimate knowledge of music sequencing software.
- Students on the course will get the opportunity to learn a musical instrument. Learning a musical instrument has shown to have a number of benefits including reducing stress, improving memory and contributing towards academic success in other subjects.
- If you go onto study music at A Level in Year 12 and 13, you will be studying for a qualification that looks excellent on your UCAS applications for university.



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
