### **COVID-19 Home school agreement**

In preparation for a partial return to the Academy for our students, Daubeney Academy will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed and quality assured in response to the COVID-19 virus pandemic;
- Follow the most up to date Government guidance for safe working practices;
- Provide a positive and caring atmosphere;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can
- Continue communicating effectively with families, as the situation develops, through newsletters, bulletins and the school and college websites
- Continue to provide work for students, when they are not in school via google classrooms or paper work packs where required
- We will continue to support your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs
- Contact parents/carers swiftly, if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19
- Inform you if staff or a student in your child's 'bubble' tests positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative

#### **As a student at Daubeney Academy I will do my best to:**

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in class and around the site
- Tell a member of staff if I feel unwell
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school
- Only use my own equipment or only that provided to me by school and no other
- Not mix with any other children in the school outside of my 'bubble'
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate
- Follow good hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it)
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others in line with the amended behaviour policy as part of our COVID-19 response

#### **To help my child at school, I know and understand that:**

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone.
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately and isolate until 14 days or until a test comes back negative.
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene
- I understand I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this COVID-19 pandemic
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe
