The Drama Learning Journey:

- In KS₃, students are encouraged to create performances from varying stimuli and are given the opportunity to produce scripted work. Students learn about different theatrical techniques and practice implementing them in their own work.
- In KS₄, students will develop an understanding of differing types of theatre including the people who work behind the scenes to create performances. Students will devise drama from a stimulus and use scripts to develop their decision making and show knowledge of theatre practitioners.
